How to use a Composition Sheet


Basic


•Every character (big and small) and punctuation mark takes up one box.

•The end of the sentence always has to match.

•When the small letters (such as $\prodentsize{D} \prodentsize{D}$) come at the end of the sentence, write it either along with the letter at the end of the sentence, or start at the beginning of the line.

•DO NOT writing anything between the lines.






When the small letters (such asゃゅょっ) come at the end of the sentence

(1) Start at the beginning of the line

OR

(2) Write the small letters along with the letter at the end of the sentence

Horizontal Composition Sheet



* In this case, small characters, periods and commas go in the lower left-hand corner.
